Dubai Way



Our flagship programme, Dubai Way provides learners with excellent knowledge of Dubai and how to combine this knowledge with customer service skills to provide memorable experiences to all travellers visiting Dubai.

By better understanding the tourism industry, Dubai's unique selling points and the key pillars of the Dubai brand, learners will be better placed to interact with both travellers and residents, and better equipped to consistently provide authentic experiences and excellent customer service.

This course will enable learners to:

- Have the knowledge and skills to help travellers with typical requests and how to provide suggestions for more complex requests.
- Provide a consistent level of customer service and information to everyone.
- Describe Dubai's tourism industry and their important role within it.
- Develop a sense of civic duty and ambassadorship towards Dubai.
- Champion the values and principles of Dubai Way.

Note: This training course meets the criteria for the requirements of the Hotel Classification section 4.1.1. 'There is a training calendar and records that all staff members are trained in Dubai Way and in other programmes as determined by Dubai Tourism'.

Inclusive Service



People of determination are just like you and play an important part in Dubai - 'the city for everyone'. They have the same rights as you, and deserve the same excellent customer service. To provide this service, you must first understand disability. The Inclusive Service training programme aims to expand learners knowledge with videos, real-life stories, activities and assessments.

This course will enable learners to:

- Explain the difference between showing empathy and sympathy.
- Discuss the difference between an impairment and a disability.
- Recall the correct terms when communicating with, and about, people of determination.
- Define different types of impairments and understand the challenges associated with each of them.
- Understand and explain how to provide inclusive service to people of determination.

Note: This training course meets the criteria for the requirements of the Hotel Classification section 4.9.3 'Universal Access Policy'.

Autism & Sensory Awareness



Dubai strives to be the go-to travel destination for people of determination. Now, our goal is to ensure that people with autism also choose Dubai as their travel destination.

Why is this important? The World Health Organisation estimates that one in one hundred people has autism (this is an estimate as diagnosis rates and methods may vary). That's eighty million people worldwide, all looking for inclusive experiences and service on their traveller journey. Dubai can be the destination people with autism and their families explore, and our latest training offering can equip traveller-facing staff to provide those inclusive, positive experiences.

Building on the Inclusive Service course, the Autism and Sensory Awareness course is the first step towards Dubai's goal of becoming a Certified Autism Destination. To achieve this goal, traveller-facing staff need to be trained and certified in autism awareness.

The content for the Autism and Sensory Awareness course was developed in collaboration with the International Board of Credentialing and Continuing Education Standards (IBCCES).

In this new course, traveller-facing staff will learn the following about people with autism:

- What their common behaviours and needs are
- The appropriate language to use
- What travel challenges they face
- ❖ How to deliver inclusive, excellent service to them.

The course is presented in a variety of engaging lesson formats, while knowledge acquisition checks will track each learner's progress. It also includes a Resources section with a downloadable Action Plan that can be used as a reference for important terms and to document ideas and observations.

By completing the Autism and Sensory Awareness course, traveller-facing staff will have the tools to provide positive experiences to visitors with autism, and help Dubai reach its goal of becoming a Certified Autism Destination.

Sustainability



The Dubai Sustainable Tourism initiative provides support to the hotel industry to ensure everyone works together towards the goals of the Dubai Integrated Energy Strategy 2030 and Dubai Clean Energy Strategy 2050.

With this training programme learners will gain knowledge of the three pillars of sustainability:

Environmental Pillar: We take our natural resources for granted and sometimes we forget that those resources are not unlimited.

Economic Pillar: The world's population is increasing and people are aspiring to have high consumption lifestyles and consuming more than their fair share.

Social Pillar: As a global citizen, we must never turn a blind eye to social disruptions that threaten the wellbeing of people, heritage and culture.

This course will enable learners to:

- Understand the role they play in championing sustainability.
- · How everyone can contribute to increase energy efficiency and resource consumption.
- Implement best operating and environmental practices.

Chinese Traveller Standards

This course will enable you to:

- Recall how the Abraham Accords impact tourism in Dubai.
- Identify the difference between Israel, Israelis, Jews and Judaism.
- Recall key phrases in Hebrew.
- Recall key observances in Judaism.
- Recognise that observance of Judaism is not the same for everyone.
- Recognise what Shabbat is and how it impacts service.
- Recall the definition of Kosher as well as which foods are kosher and which are not.

How it Works?



Once your establishment confirms its participation in the Dubai Way, you will receive an email with an activation link to register your establishment.



Once registered successfully, you will receive an email with the code for your establishment.

This code is exclusively for your establishment.



Provide the establishment code to employees who can then proceed to register online.



Students will register for Dubai Way programmes. The list of registered students is always available for the establishment administrator to view from the Dubai Way platform. A monthly invoice will be generated based on the number of registered and approved students.



Once employees who register are approved by the establishment administrator, they can proceed with their course and complete their assessment.

How an Employee Registers?



Register online at dubaiway.ae. You will need your employer's establishment code and your Emirates ID to complete the registration process.



Once you have registered, select the training course you would like to take.



Your employer must approve your course request. Once the course is approved, you can continue the training.



After you have finished the course. You will then be able to download and print a copy of your certificate.




ESTABLISHMENT ADMINISTRATOR GUIDE

Below are the steps required for an establishment to operate the Dubai Way platform.


STEP 1:

- Click on 'Login'.
- Use the establishment email address and password to Login.



STEP 2:

• The Registration Report page will appear with five tabs across the top bar.




STEP 3:

The registration report shows all students who have registered with the establishment code.

To run a rgistration report:

- Click search



STEP 4:


 The student report shows all students who have registered AND who have moved to the establishment (using establishment change request)

STEP 5:


- The Employees report shows all employees who are sponsored on the establishment visa via GDRFA

Click Dashboard





STEP 7:

Student Course requests

• This will allow you, as the administrator to APPROVE or DECLINE course requests

STEP 8:

Change Establishment Request

This allows a student to move from one establishment to another.

First the student has to DELINK.
Then the student LINKS to the new establishment by using the establishments code.
Then the establishment administrator approves the student moving and the student records will appear in student reports.




HOW TO UPDATE EMAIL ADDRESS




STEP 4:

• Click on Update Email. Press 'Update'.




STEP 5:

• Enter the new email address.




STEP 6:

HOW TO PRINT COURSE CERTIFICATE

 The final assessment must be completed before a certificate can be generated.



STEP 3:

- Once you have successfully completed the final assessment, the option to download certificate will appear onscreen.
- · Click on 'Download Certificate'.



STEP 4:

- Once downloaded, the certificate can be printed.
- Best printing occurs in landscape format.
